

LISA Agreement & information letter:

You are agreeing to play on Live in Studio A on KDVS 90.3 FM on Thursday, _____, 2010 from 11 pm to midnight.

This is a one hour show and you carry the whole hour. There is no MC or interviewer unless you arrange one in advance. It is a just like a performance you would do before any live audience. The sound engineer will cue you when you are on air and you take it from there.

So treat this live performance just as you would any other live performance. **#1 Show up!** If for a good reason you must cancel, make sure you make contact with Karen Carchidi at least a week in advance (except under extreme difficult conditions) and make sure she can find a replacement.

Check with the engineer to find out what we have available as far as equipment, but you might want to bring any amps, cables, special microphones, or whatever you need to do a live show. We have microphones, mic stands, vocal/instrument monitors, and an engineer.

Most bands play for the full hour. You are free to talk to your audience, be informative, tell them about shows, tell clean jokes or stories, introduce band members, give your website, etc. Make sure there is not a lot of "dead-air". Also, please give a little plug to the band that will play the following week on LISA. Contact Karen Carchidi for this information.

Please remember that while it is all right if your lyrics contain swear words, it is NEVER ok to swear while you're just talking on the air.

The show starts at 11PM. Bands are asked to arrive at around 9PM to unload equipment, set up, and do a sound check. All bands are given a copy of the show they just performed. There is no need to bring a CD or jewel case. Both will be provided.

You may bring a reasonable number of guests. Alcohol is not allowed in the station by FCC and university laws.

To promote the show, encourage listeners to tune in at 90.3 FM in the area, or to stream live online at www.kdvs.org (link it!).

We can use pictures and information you have provided us on our website to promote your appearance. We also do a small press release to local press, and occasionally (but not always) artists will be contacted by the college paper or local newspaper, so look out for that.

********* We now have a person coming in each week to film the LISA shows! *********

We will film the entire set and pick select songs to put on our new LISA youtube channel. Let us know if you are okay with this as soon as you are sure. That way we can give our camera people good notice. You will receive a copy of the footage at least a month after the show. Please give us an address to send the footage.

Please email the engineer **Fenris Wulf** (fenriswulfaudio@yahoo.com) one week before your show and let him know what your set up is so he can be prepared. Be sure to give him a contact number for your group. Let him know how many musicians, instruments and equipment you have and/or need. Feel free to e-mail Fenris with any other questions you might have about sound & setup.

Directions:

To get to KDVS, take 80 towards Davis. Merge onto 113 North towards Woodland and exit at Russell Blvd. Make a right onto Russell and head east for about a mile. You will see UC Davis on your right. Make a right onto Howard Way, into the UCD Campus. You will pass a parking structure on your left. Pull up to the curb by the Information Booth, making sure not to block any busses.

Parking is free after 10pm at the parking structure that you pass on your way to the station (by the entrance of the campus). It generally takes about an hour or so to get all equipment down and set up. It is safe to wait to move your car to the parking structure till just before 10 (even if you get to the station right at 9pm).

If there isn't anyone to greet you, you can call the KDVS lobby at (530)752-0728. Someone should answer and come upstairs to meet you. KDVS is located in 14 Lower Freeborn, in the basement of the building to the right of you as you stand looking south from the information booth.
